



2021 Summer Programs

Summer Term Private Lessons

\$200 CAD/5 hours of instruction; \$125 CAD/3 hours of instruction, or \$45 CAD/hour.

*Instruction time must be completed by August 31

- Students are not required to commit to a set lesson time each week. Pay for the amount of instruction time you want and schedule it around your summer schedules. Some weeks you might not schedule a lesson while some weeks you might schedule more than one lesson.
- Lessons may be scheduled in 30, 45, 60, 90 or 120 minute time slots.
- Regular Missed Lesson Policies apply. Weekday and evening spots available.
- Time-slots are on a first come basis and cannot be booked until fees are paid.
- Lessons will take place online via Zoom. In-person lessons *may* be available for Kingston students depending on public health policies.

Weekly Summer Online Group Classes

Singing Sensations (Ages 6-8) Tuesdays 6:00-6:30 EDT; \$40 CAD/8 weeks

Vocal Performance (Ages 9-12) Thursdays 6:00-6:30 EDT; \$40 CAD/8 weeks

Adult Voice Class (students 16+) Wednesdays 7:30-8:00 EDT; \$40 CAD/8 weeks

- Students will learn about posture, breathing, and a healthy tone placement while learning fun and engaging music.
- Each class will include a live Zoom Call and follow up interactive activities to inspire and foster a love of music through singing and musical activities.
- Practice material will be made available to students via the Cadenza Practice App.
- Registration is on a first come basis. Limit of 6 students per class.

Songwriting for Beginners (Ages 8-14) Wednesdays 6:00-7:00 EDT; \$80 CAD/8 weeks

- Students will learn and explore songwriting techniques through various musical styles.
- Students should have experience with either piano, ukulele or guitar and a basic understanding of music notation and/or chord theory.
- Each class will include a live Zoom Call and follow up activities to help them on their songwriting journey. One on one coaching will be part of the song writing process and take place during class time. Although it won't be mandatory, students will be encouraged to share their work through out the songwriting process.
- Materials and assignments will be made available to students via the Cadenza Practice App. Students will also use the Audacity App for recording purposes.
- Registration is on a first come basis. Limit of 6 students.

Summer Online Camp Program

Musical Theatre Camp (Ages 7-14) M-F July 26-August 6; 9:30-12:00 EDT; \$150/2 weeks

- Students will receive training in Voice (speech & singing), Dance/Movement/Body Awareness, Improvisation, Character Development/Script Work, and Scene Writing/Collective Creation, through games and activities geared towards online learning. A short performance for family will take place on the final day.
- Sessions will take place via live Zoom Call. Each day will include community building activities, warm-ups, and snack time/screen break.
- Students may need to print some learning materials at home and have a second device available to play musical accompaniments. Follow up activities/practice material may be assigned for students to look at before the next day's session.
- Registration is on a first come basis. Limit of 12 students.
